Position Overview

The Music Educator will teach age-appropriate techniques in music to include many genres, composition, instruments, history, vocal technique and artists from the past to the present. Joe's offers classes for toddlers, school-age children, and teenagers. Classes must be inclusive for all levels and accommodate differing abilities. Music genres, associated vocabulary and theory should be integral components of a class.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Develop curriculum, identify themes, objectives, goals, and methods for classes.
- Teach music technique basics, theory, history and vocals incorporating creative methods of learning and play to engage all students.
- Motivate students to create rhythms and simple melodic musical idea incorporating movement.
- Introduce and build music vocabulary while supporting students with creating lyrical compositions.
- Instruct students in preparation for presenting musical and vocal pieces.
- Communicate with potential and existing partners to coordinate extensions, schedule activities, as required for programs.
- Manage student files, track attendance, document achievements and submit weekly updates to the program supervisor.
- Attend meetings, program planning sessions and trainings for the benefit of programs.
- Promote organizational events to class participants and families.
